The Challenge takes place at Cape Vidal and all spearos are welcome to take part. For spectators, a discount is being offered – please see the entrance form below for details:

## <u>IMPORTANT NOTE</u>: (Please read and note the ID requirement- General point 4) Once again competitors' campsite and gate entry fees are included in the entry fee.

Collect your disc from the Vidal offices before departure to allow the vehicle to exit the gate.

## **Rules:**

- 1) All fish landed have to comply with the Natal Conservation Service rules for the area Game fish only, species limits, valid spear fishing license (skipper only to have boat license as well) etc.
- 2) Diving to be limited to the Cape Vidal Reserve area only, i.e. from the beacon at the beginning of the reserve at Leven Point southwards to the beacon immediately south of Cape Vidal signifying the end of the Reserve. Other areas **may** be considered for shoredivers only.
- 3) Any entrant venturing into the Sanctuary will be disqualified.
- 4) The competition will take place on Saturday the (to be confirmed) 17<sup>th</sup> MAY and will be held from sunrise 'til the weigh-in at the community center at the Cape Vidal campsites at 4 o'clock sharp. Late comers will be disqualified.
- 5) All fish must be gutted and gilled.
- 6) No fish can win more than one prize e.g. if a fish is weighed in for the biggest fish it is then removed from that competitor's bag and thus cannot be included for Biggest bag if the competitor is eligible for it or its Species prize.
- 7) The Wahoo Committee's decision is final.

## General

- 1) Competitors' campsite and gate entry fees are included in the entry fee.
- 2) There is no need to pre-book a campsite as these have already been allocated and paid for.
- 3) The entrance fee for the weekend is **R400 for paid up Wahoo members**, **R450 other competitors and R400 for non-competitors. Non-members can pay R510 and get Wahoo Club membership included in the price.** Payments to reach Wahoo no later than the 7<sup>th</sup> of May 2002. There is a cut-off of 120 entrants, handled on a first come first serve basis.
- 4) This fee covers campsite fee, gate entry (Entrants will need <u>positive ID</u> for checking against a paid up participant list at the gate to facilitate entry.), all meals, snacks, boat packs, cool drinks, as much beer as you can drink and entrance to the comp including a T-Shirt.
- 5) THE ENTRY FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.
- 6) Prizes will be allocated for boat divers, paddle skis and shore divers and will be detailed at the sign on
- 7) Sign on is on Friday evening 16<sup>TH</sup> MAY at the Communal Hall.
- 8) Please note that at this point the Natal Conservation Service are bound by law not to allow beach vehicles to drive up the beach to places like Leven Point.
